- 5. During medical screening of donors to identify the high-risk behaviour in a blood donor and counselling of donor by maintaining confidentiality and privacy.
- 6. Post-donation counselling about Dos and Don'ts to the donors.
- 7. Collecting donor feedback for each donation.
- 8. In case of TTI (HIV/HBV/HCV/Syphilis) Positivity recalling the donor for second sample collection and preliminary counselling.
- 9. If second sample came positive- counselling the particular donor and referring the donor to local ICTC and STI clinic as per Govt. policy.
- 10. Sending letters to all sero-positive donors regarding their status of blood serology reports.
