

Consultant- GI – HPB Surgery (Colorectal)

Conceptualized in the year 2004 as a philanthropic initiative for the Eastern and North-Eastern parts of India and the neighbouring countries, the Tata Medical Center (TMC) started operations in Kolkata on May 16, 2011. The hospital is governed by a charitable trust – Tata Medical Centre Trust. It is an integrated Oncology facility with well-trained professional staff and equipped with modern facilities and the most contemporary medical equipment. The hospital was designed by Cannon Design, a renowned architectural firm from North America. It is located on 13 acres of land at New Town in Kolkata, West Bengal.

The hospital is an integrated Oncology facility with well-trained professional staff and equipped with modern facilities and contemporary medical equipment. The Hospital, with a capacity of 437 beds, serves all sections of the society, with 75% of the infrastructure earmarked for subsidized treatment for the underprivileged sections. It provides a wide spectrum of services from diagnosis and therapy to rehabilitation and palliative support. It is also a teaching institute with fellowship, DNB and DrNB courses in oncology specialties and super specialties. The Institution's objective is to excel in service, education and research.

This state-of-the-art Hospital has been built on carefully landscaped grounds to emphasize the holistic approach in our crusade against cancer. The buildings were designed by Cannon Design, a renowned architectural firm from North America.

Diagnosis and treatment are characterized by a multi-disciplinary approach with Disease Management Teams, wherein experts from different streams participate in decision-making for treatment protocols, using evidence-based medical strategies and appropriate documented clinical guidelines.

Tata Medical Center, Kolkata, has strived to be one of the leading cancer care and research institutions in the country and has benefited West Bengal as well as the adjoining states and neighboring countries.

The GI HPB Oncosurgery unit takes pride in offering the entire range of GI Surgical Oncology treatment. In order to offer specialised surgical care, the unit is functionally divided into three sub-specialities:

- (1) Upper gastrointestinal and peritoneal surface oncology
- (2) Hepato-pancreatico-biliary surgery
- (3) Colorectal surgery

It is currently run by four consultants, who are supported by six to eight Fellows (Post MCh/MS). We run outpatient clinics Monday to Friday and operate six whole-day lists every week. Minimal access surgery with conventional laparoscope and Da Vinci robotic operations are performed routinely. We also do cytoreductive surgery and HIPEC on a regular basis. Since inception we have done more than 12000 major operations. We assist Gyne Oncology and Urology (cytoreductive surgery and IVC thrombectomy respectively). Journal presentation, audit and multidisciplinary meetings complete the weekly academic roster. Data capture in Redcap and internal assessment of trainees are regular feature. Clinicians are ably supported by a full time data entry operator. We regularly present at international and national conferences and encourage members to undertake self-development training courses. The department is running DrNB Surgical Oncology programme and training the DrNB surgical oncology trainees.

1. MCh/DrNB in GI Surgery with additional training in Colorectal Oncosurgery. Desirable, to have training in MIS and Robotic Surgery.

2. MCh/DrNB in Surgical oncology with GI specific work experience (colorectal). Desirable to have training in MIS and Robotic Surgery.

Experience: Minimum 1-2 years post MCh.

Job responsibilities:

The newly appointed Consultant Colorectal Surgeon will be responsible for providing expertise to further develop Colorectal Surgery at TMC. Experience with minimal access surgical techniques will be preferable.

- Teaching surgical trainees
