

## TATA MEDICAL CENTER – MEDICAL OFFICER – URO-ONCOSURGERY

Established in 2004 as a philanthropic initiative to serve Eastern and North-Eastern India and neighboring countries, Tata Medical Center began operations in Kolkata on May 16, 2011. Governed by the Tata Medical Centre Trust, it is a comprehensive oncology facility staffed by highly trained professionals and equipped with advanced, modern technology.

With a capacity of 437 beds, the hospital is committed to inclusive care, dedicating 50% of its infrastructure to subsidized treatment for underprivileged patients. It offers a full continuum of cancer care—from diagnosis and treatment to rehabilitation and palliative support—guided by a multidisciplinary, evidence-based approach through Disease Management Teams.

Focused on excellence in service, education, and research, the institution is designed to support holistic cancer care within a thoughtfully planned environment. Over the years, it has emerged as a leading cancer care and research center, benefiting patients across West Bengal, neighboring states, and nearby countries.

To further these objectives, Tata Medical Center invites applications for the position of Medical Officer in Uro-Oncosurgery.

### THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Uro-Oncosurgery delivers evidence-based, protocolized care for all urological cancers, with comprehensive diagnostic and therapeutic services. It is supported by multidisciplinary specialties, including oncology, radiology, pathology, and intensive care, along with a robust EMR system for efficient data management.

The department features dedicated ICU, HDU, and surgical wards, advanced operating facilities with open, endoscopic, and laparoscopic equipment, and an active robotic surgery (da Vinci) program since 2017 with weekly procedures.

### STAFFING

The department comprises 4 full-time consultants, 4 dedicated Uro-Oncosurgery fellows, 2 rotating surgical fellows, and 2 urology technicians. The Medical Officer is involved in both inpatient and outpatient care, with opportunities to assist in surgical procedures. The role also provides exposure to the fundamentals of cancer care, evidence-based medicine, and a multidisciplinary treatment approach.
