Details of Training and Experience

I completed my MBBS in 2006 from M.S. Ramaiah medical college, Bangalore. I was also involved in a research project “The study of breast-feeding practices among working mothers of M.S. Ramaiah Group of institutions & Micro Research for establishing Crèche Facility in the campus”, during the period March to May 2007. I completed my compulsory rotating internship in 2007.

I finished my post-graduation in general surgery from the same college in 2011. As a part of my post-graduate thesis I conducted a study on evaluation of emergency cholecystectomy in Acute cholecystitis.

Wanting to further specialize in the field of gastrointestinal surgery I joined post-doctoral fellowship in colorectal surgery at Christian medical college, Vellore. I finished the same in August

2014. As a part of my fellowship I was the principal investigator of a randomised trial: "Comparison of circumferential resection margin in standard versus extralevator abdominoperineal resection – A randomised control trial." The trial is currently on going at CMC, Vellore.

I joined the department at CMC as Senior resident and was further promoted to Assistant Professor. I was performing various colorectal surgeries both benign and malignant during my tenure independently and was also actively involved in teaching undergraduates, post-graduates and nursing students.

During the same time I was awarded the international travelling fellowship from Indian society of colo-rectal surgeons (ACRSI) and the American society of colo-rectal surgery (ASCRS). As a part of the award I attended the ASCRS conference at Los Angeles, USA and did observership at Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center, Hartford, CT, USA for 4 weeks.

I subsequently moved to Kolkata in 2016 and joined Tata Medical Center (TMC) for a 2yr GI oncology fellowship. I joined the department at TMC in 2018 as Consultant surgeon with a special interest in colorectal surgery.
