Location

Located just opposite Newtown Police Station, the campus is well connected by government and private bus services from Sealdah, Howrah Station, the Airport, South Kolkata, E.M. Bye Pass, North Kolkata and Esplanade (Dharmatala).

Out-of-State Educational Visit

Students undertake an out-of-state educational visit as part of the programme; costs related to this visit are to be borne by the student.

Anti-Ragging Policy

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the Institution and Hostel, in accordance with Government of India, UGC and Indian Nursing Council rules and regulations. The Institution will take necessary action against any student found involved in an incident of ragging. Students may directly report any such incident to the Anti-Ragging Committee, which will take a decision on the complaint or report.

Fee Structure

Total Course Fee: Rs. 1,30,000 (One Lakh Thirty Thousand only), payable over two years as detailed below. All payments must be made through a Bank Draft drawn in favour of “TATA MEDICAL CENTRE TRUST”, payable at Kolkata. Money receipts will be issued by the Finance Department of Tata Medical Centre.

Phase 2	Within the 5th month of Year 2	30,000

Course fees are non-refundable under any circumstances. Caution money will be refunded only after declaration of the final year result, on submission of all fee receipts, a complete clearance declaration from all departments, and an application for refund of caution money.

Other Fees & Requirements

Hostel Fees	Rs. 4,000 per month (applicable only to students living in the hostel; to be paid to the Finance Department within the 10th of each month). Hostel availability is subject to vacancy.
University Fees	University Registration fee, Migration fee (if applicable), University Examination fee and Dissertation fee are charged separately, as per the West Bengal University of Health Sciences. These are to be deposited directly by students through the University's online portal as and when notified.
Uniform	Two sets of uniform with lab coat, one pair of white covered shoes and white socks are required during clinical postings. Uniforms are stitched by TMC's own vendor and paid for directly by the candidate; shoes and socks are to be purchased separately by the student.
Medical Examination	Candidates must bring a medical fitness certificate issued by the Medical Board at their present place of residence, along with reports of: CBC; Fasting and P.P. Blood Sugar; Serological test; Chest X-Ray; and Urine and Stool routine tests, at the time of admission.
