Information about Admission for M.Sc. in Medical-Surgical Nursing- Oncology Nursing Course

Tata Medical Center, Kolkata is a super speciality Oncology Hospital, inaugurated by Mr. Ratan N Tata on 16th May, 2011.

The Tata Medical Center, Kolkata is a comprehensive Cancer Care Center, equipped with modern facilities and the most contemporary medical equipment. The Hospital with a current capacity of 437 beds serves all sections of the society, with 50% earmarked for free or subsidized treatment for the underprivileged sections.

A. Philosophy of the Institution:

The Tata Group has always believed in returning wealth to the Society it serves. It has established philanthropic trusts which have created National Institutions in Science and Technology, Medical Research, Social Studies and the Performing Arts.

Tata Medical Center (TMC), Kolkata is a philanthropic initiative from the House of Tata.

B. Vision and Mission of the Institution:

The Tata Medical Center is envisioned to be a state-of-the-art total Cancer Care Center which will promote Prevention, Diagnosis and Treatment, Rehabilitation and Palliation and Research. The Institution's mission is to excel in patient service, as well as education and research in the field of oncology.

C. Objective and Aim of the Institution

The Institution's objective is to excel in service, education and research in oncology.

The Institution aims to be one of the leading Cancer Care and Research Institutions in the country and will benefit West Bengal as well as the adjoining states and neighboring countries.

D. Location of the Institution.

This Institution is located at New Town in the Rajarhat area of Kolkata on 13 acres of land and is managed by a professional management body reporting to the Tata Medical Centre Trust (TMCT), Kolkata.

Its particular location is just opposite to Newtown Police Station. It is well connected by Govt. and private bus services from Sealdah, Kolkata and Howrah Station, Airport, South Kolkata, E.M Bye Pass, and North Kolkata and esplanade (Dhramatala)

E. M.Sc. Nursing Course

The Institution has started M.Sc. in Medical–Surgical Nursing – Oncology Nursing Speciality Course from 2013. The Institute is affiliated with West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata and recognized by Indian Nursing Council, New-Delhi.

Admission Capacity- 15/year.

Clinical Speciality : Medical Surgical Nursing – Oncology Nursing.

F. Course Fees- Rs. 1,30,000.00 (One Lakh Thirty Thousand) (for two years)

I. Submission of Course fees :

- **1st year- Rs 65, 000 (Rs. Sixty Five Thousand- Payment will be taken in two phases)**
 - ◆ **1st Phase- Rs. 35,000 (Thirty Five thousand)** – at the time of admission in the course.
 - ◆ **2nd phase- Rs. 30,000 (Thirty Thousand)** – within 5th month of the academic session.

**Caution Money (Refundable) – Rs. 5,000 (Five Thousand) - one time only to be given during admission.

- **Student Identity Card Payment - Rs. 200 (Rs. Two Hundred) - one time only to be given during admission.**
- **Total Amount of Money to be paid during admission- 40,200 (Forty Thousand two hundred)**

- **2nd Year- Rs. 65,000 (Sixty-Five Thousand- Payment will be taken in two Phases)**
 - ◆ **1st Phase – Rs. 35,000 (Rs. Thirty-Five Thousand)-** in the beginning of 2nd year.
 - ◆ **2nd Phase- Rs. 30,000 (Rs. Thirty Thousand)** – within 5th month of 2nd year

II. Course fees are non-refundable whatever may be the cause.

**Caution Money will be refunded after declaration of Final year result. All receipts of Course fees, complete clearance declaration from all departments along with an application for refund of caution money will be submitted for claiming of caution money.

All Payments should be given through Bank Draft drawn in favor of **“TATA MEDICAL CENTRE TRUST” Payable at KOLKATA.** Money receipts will be given from Finance Department of Tata Medical Centre.

G. Other Fees- Hostel fees - Rs. 4000 (Rs. Four Thousand) per Month (applicable only for Hostel Living Students) – will be given to Finance Department within **10th of each month**. Availability of Hostel depends on vacancy.

H. Out State Educational Visit- Costs related to this to be borne by the student.

I. University Fees- University Registration fees, Migration fees (if applicable), University Examination fees, Dissertation Fees will be taken separately. Amount of fees related to University will be taken as per announcement of West Bengal University of Health Sciences. Students will directly deposit all these fees through online portal of the West Bengal University of health science as and when notice given by the university.

J. Uniform- Two sets of uniform with lab Coat, one pair of White covered shoes and white socks are required during clinical posting. Candidates will directly pay the total cost of uniform to the vendor. Uniform will be stitched by TMC'S own vendor. Student will purchase their own Shoes and socks.

K. Medical Examination- Students are advised to bring medical fitness certificate issued by the Medical Board of the present place of posting along with reports of Blood test (CBC; Fasting and P.P Blood Sugar; Serological test, Chest X-Ray, Urine and Stool for Routine test at the time of admission.

L. Anti-Ragging- Ragging is totally prohibited in the Institution and Hostel as per Government of India, UGC and Indian Nursing Council Rules and Regulations. Institution will take necessary action against the student if any complaint or report of any type of Ragging. Students can directly report to the Anti Ragging Committee in case of any situation occurs. Anti-Ragging Committee will take decision on that complaint or report.
